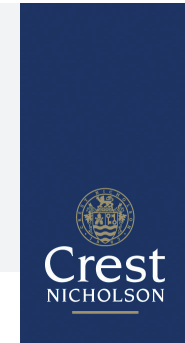


# ARBORFIELD GARDEN VILLAGE

In 2011 the Government decided that Arborfield Garrison would close in 2015, with military services relocating to the former RAF Lyneham in Wiltshire and the site developed as a new community.

Crest Nicholson PLC was selected as the Defence Infrastructure Organisation's (DIO) Development Manager in April 2013, with hybrid planning permission granted by Wokingham Borough Council in April 2015. A new community including up to 2,000 homes and a wealth of new community facilities and infrastructure, to support both new and existing residents alike, is planned for the former garrison site, which will take shape over the next 10-15 years.

In early 2015 Crest Nicholson gave local residents and stakeholders the opportunity to help choose a name for marketing purposes of the new Arborfield Garden Village development. We received a great response and we have decided to undertake a second stage of consultation as part of naming the new development. The closing date for the receipt of suggested names is 4th December 2015.

A final shortlist of names will be made public, and you'll then have the opportunity to vote for your favourite from the shortlist.
